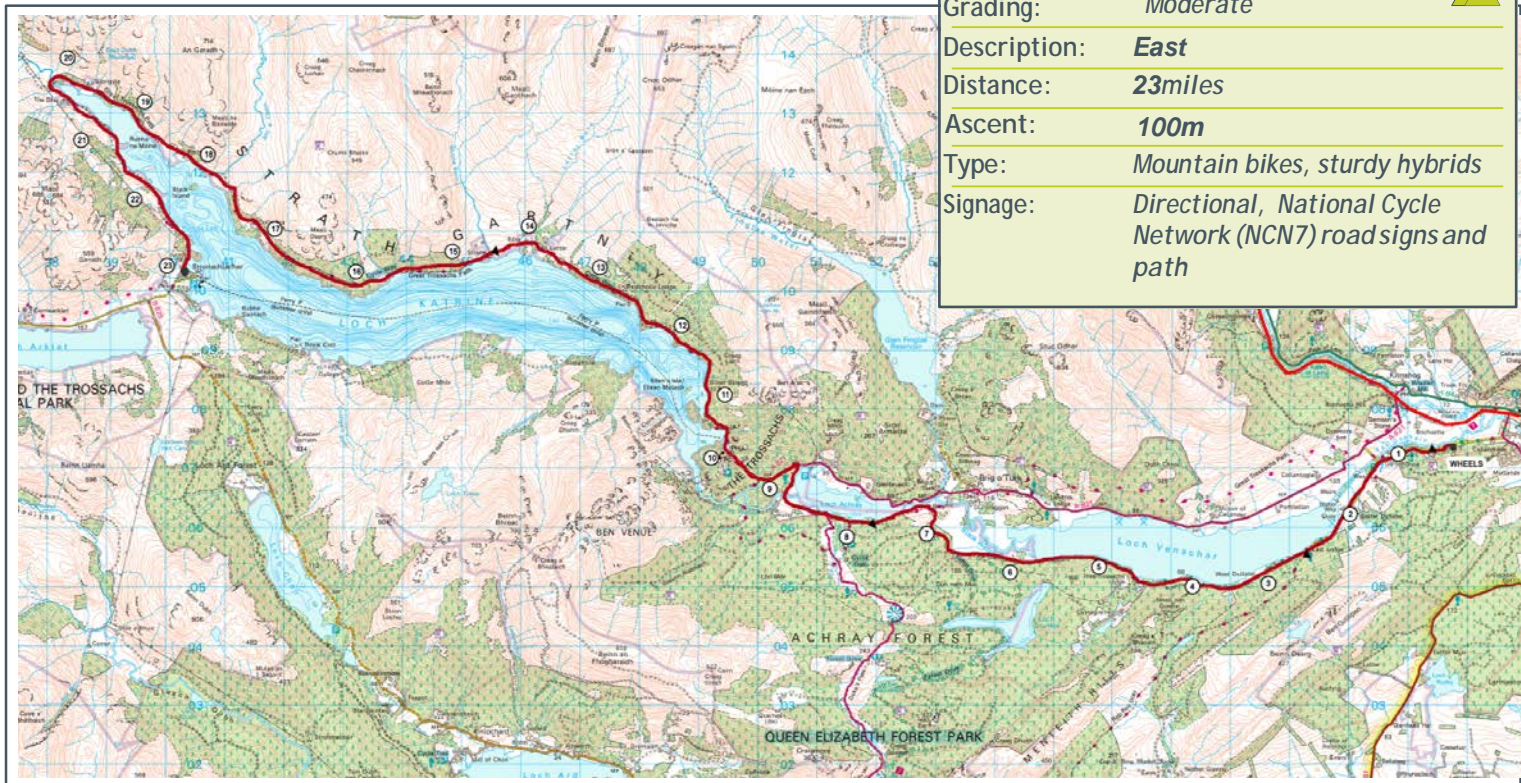


# Callander to Stronachlacher

## Route Description

Callander to Stronachlacher offers Families the ideal escape for the day with spectacular views along Loch Venachar and Loch Katrine while passing through wild unspoilt forest regions.

From Wheels Cycling Centre turn left the Initial 7.2km follows the quiet rural road shared with NCN7. follow the loch side path with distant views of the pyramidal Ben A'an (461m).

At the end of Loch Venachar follow the road along the lochside until reaching the signs for Loch Katrine Pier

The cycle to Stronachlacher follows a linear tarmac path along picturesque Loch Katrine this can be combined with the steamer sailing from Trossachs Pier. It can also be cycled in the other direction, catching the afternoon sailing from Stronachlacher. The route also makes a good, and popular, cycle, although bikes must be booked on the boat in advance.
